<u>Summer Reading</u>

The Summer Reading Program, from June 1st through August 16th, is for all ages. Log your reading to help Livermore reach our Community Reading Goal of <u>3 Million Minutes</u> this summer.

Directions for all ages:

- Register and receive a prize for signing up on Beanstack. (Prizes available June 1. If you used Beanstack last year, you can use the same log-in.)
 - 2Log your reading and activities.
 - 3.Earn Prizes!

If you prefer a paper game board, you may pick one up at any Livermore Public Library branch starting June 1.

<u>Prizes for Pre-Readers are:</u> A book of your choice, Play-Dough or a finger puppet, bubbles, an award ribbon and sticker, and a raffle ticket to be used towards great prizes.

<u>Prizes for Teens Readers are:</u> A magnetic bookmark, snack pack, 5 vinyl stickers of your choice, a reusable water bottle, and a raffle ticket to be used towards great prizes

<u>Prizes for Independent Readers:</u> A book of your choice, Chick-Fil-A dessert/LARPD Swim Pass/Papa Murphy's Pizza, an activity kit, a gold medal and name on library wall, and a raffle ticket to be used towards great prizes.

<u>Prizes for Adult Readers:</u> A flower seed bookmark, and raffle tickets to be used towards great prizes.

To complete the reading game, pre-readers will read 40 books with their caregivers, while everyone else will read for 15 hours. To earn tickets for the raffle prizes, participants can complete two activity badges during the reading game, and read additional hours beyond the completion time. Pre-readers can read an extra ten books, up to 100 books, to earn raffle tickets, while everyone else can earn an additional raffle ticket for every 5 hours more they read (up to a maximum of 100 hours).
